The awards were open to all ArchiTeam members around Australia, and the 2025 expert jury comprised of prominent figures in Australia's Architectural community, including ArchiTeam member (Awards Chair) Michael Roper, Architecture architecture (Vic), Thomas Bailey – Room11 (Tas), Jemima Retallack - Retallack Thompson Architects (NSW), Anita Panov - panov scott (NSW), Andrew Steele – Studio Nine (SA), Monique Woodward – WOWOWA (Vic), Andrew Klenke - Swanbury Penglase Architects (SA), Clémence Carayol, Architecture&Design, Digital Editor (Media Judge) and ArchiTeam Awards Director Wesley Spencer.

The ArchiTeam 2025 Awards included various categories such as,

- Community & Public Award sponsored by DECO

Additionally, the Australian Passivhaus Association continue to provide ArchiTeam members with the Passivhaus Scholarship, offering the winner access to become a certified Passivhaus Consultant.
